



## The AUD Community Pledge

Being a part of the AUD community means that each of us must take extraordinary steps to stay well and protect each other, both on and off campus. Members of our community are reminded that in their conduct, whether on campus or off, they are representatives of AUD. It is the responsibility of each AUD member to adhere to this pledge to protect our on-campus community and the community at large.

**I pledge to take responsibility for my own health and the protection of others, and I pledge to help keep the AUD community safe from the spread of COVID-19 and other infections. As a member of the AUD community, I pledge to:**

### PROTECT MYSELF

- Monitor for the symptoms of COVID-19 through my daily symptoms, and follow the prompts for seeking medical attention if necessary.
- Wash my hands often with soap and water. Use hand sanitizer when it is available.

### PROTECT OTHERS

- Maintain appropriate social distancing (2 meters) both indoors and outdoors.
- Stay home if I feel ill or after exposure to someone who is ill or has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Wear a mask and other protective gear in public areas and inside all buildings, as well as outdoors when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Be positive, attentive, and helpful to anyone who may need support.

### PROTECT THE AUD COMMUNITY

- Greet without shaking hands.
- Respect personal space and practice two-meter physical distancing.
- Practice good hygiene.
- Disinfect my living space and personal items regularly.
- Work to mitigate spread of germs and viruses on frequently touched surfaces and objects.
